For more than five years, Lisa Lindvay has been developing a series of photographs depicting the lives of her father, half-sister, and two half-brothers as they take on the burden of her mother's deteriorating mental health. An extended look at the physical and emotional currents within her home, the images are a visual representation of the internal dilemmas associated with this entropic state. The photographs expose how her mother's illness influences the condition of the space and emotional well being of her family members. This is an exploration of how individual identity is shaped and altered within the familial relationship. The work exposes the ideal family—a mother and father, some siblings, a nice home—as a rarity. It's much more complex than that.
